



Parks & Gardens

Pack a picnic and let the kids run free. Anchoring Albury's main street, the Albury Botanic Gardens has enchanted visitors for over 130 years. The Children's **Garden** nestled within is always popular - with life-sized dinosaurs, a fairy temple, a troll's cave and loads of activities to spark imagination, shaded by stately trees.

Surrounding a charming lake, and home to friendly waterbirds is Belvoir Park. Bring your doggo to run in the leash-free fenced playpark with two agility runs, while kids of all ages can explore the huge adventure playground with access for all, including a liberty swing.







Nature for everybody

Every spring, the hills around Albury Wodonga explode into a patchwork of colour with Chocolate Lillies, Milk Maids and Blue Bells dotting Nail Can Hill. From atop Huon Hill, take in a 360-degree view of Albury Wodonga and the surrounding landscape, including a glimpse of the peaks of Mount Bogong, and Feathertop. Be prepared for sizzling sunrise and sunset snaps from this lookout!

Take up a spot in one of the many bird hides to view native birds and wildlife at the peaceful Wonga Wetlands.



On the lake

Don't miss our photogenic landmark and aquatic playground, Lake Hume. From the awe-inspiring dam wall to the cool waters of the lake itself (holding six times the volume of Sydney Harbour), this iconic location is an easy 15 minutes from town. The foreshore offers plenty of places to set up a picnic and laze the day away swimming and paddling in the shallows. If you're feeling more adventurous, talk to Adventure Ski who'll hook you up with a fun day of wakeboarding, water-skiing, or tube-riding.





The Mighty Murray

More than a border, it draws a line for natural discovery. At Noreuil Park, you'll find expansive lawns and shady trees right on the riverbank. There are modern, clean barbecues, a choice of children's playgrounds and the beautiful **River Deck** Café takes pride of place. If you feel like hitting the water, grab a canoe or kayak from Murray River Canoe Hire. Indulge in fishing, stand-up paddleboarding, or simply drift along with the current. To stay as close as possible to the water, there's free riverside camping at Richardson's Bend.





Tracks & Trails

Discover over 90 kilometres of paths to roam, by foot or by pedal. Enjoy the shady rivergum canopy as you walk the magical Yindvamarra Sculpture Walk. Pause for a while to connect with First Nation's stories at any of the 15 sculptures, created by local Aboriginal artists. There's native flora and fauna at McFarlane's Hill to uncover, where walking tracks take you over rolling hills and alongside crystal clear streams.



Delicious Dining

Albury Wodonga sits at the centre of an abundant food bowl where there's dining options for every taste bud. Start your day with a fresh hearty brekky at **BeanStation** and you're set to discover.

From a simple and scrumptious wood-fired pizza at buzzy Downtown Pizzeria to a choice of fine dining restaurants like Bistro Selle, you'll find we take our food very seriously. Creative and passionate chefs source the best local ingredients at our weekly Albury Wodonga Farmers Market.

Pubs & Bars

Neighbouring Towns

High country, wine country, and everything in-between! Head north to the village of Holbrook and find out why there's a giant submarine stationed in the main street. On return, stop in at Jindera Pioneer Museum, built around an existing 1847 general store, homes, grounds and machinery sheds. Hug the gentle bends of the river with a day's drive to the final resting place of 'The Man from Snowy River' at Corryong. Just an hour out, at Lockhart, Green's Gunyah Museum houses an intriguing collection of artefacts, and the wonderful Doris Golder Wool Art Gallery.
