



Waterfalls within 1 hour of Albury Wodonga

Barry Falls	Woolshed Valley Off Beechworth/ Chiltern Rd, El Dorado	Barry Falls is most spectacular during the spring months when there is still plenty of water runoff from the hills. The falls are an easy walk which is great for the whole family.
Granya Falls	Cottontree Campground Granya Road, Granya	Short walk from Cottontree Creek picnic area Nearby is Scouts hut built in 1937
Indigo Falls	Ewarts Road, off the Beechworth-Wodonga Road, Baranduda Regional State Park	Secluded waterfall, just off Ewarts Road, approx. 50 metres from car park. Lush, green forest of Baranduda Ranges.
Woolshed Falls	Beechworth-Chiltern Road, Beechworth	A ten minute drive from Beechworth on the Beechworth-Chiltern Road. Viewing platform is located close to the carpark and there is access to explore the area around Falls.



Waterfalls within 2 hours of Albury Wodonga

Bluff Falls	Burrowa-Pine Mountain National Park Bluff Falls Road, Cudgewa	Water cascades off the park plateau, over Cudgewa Bluff and into the grotto below. Parking and turning is limited.
Ladies Bath Falls and Rollasons Falls	Mount Buffalo Road, Mount Buffalo National Park	Ladies Bath Falls – accessed via a short drive up the Mount Buffalo tourist drive, and a short walk to the falls. Further up the tourist drive is Rollasons Falls – a 3km return track to view waterfall from above and below.
Fainter Falls	High Plains Road, Mount Beauty	Water flows all year round, start the walk opposite the car park, follow the signed walking track for spectacular views of the falls and the river. The walk is approx. 700m.
Paradise Falls and Little Falls	Paradise Falls Rd, Cheshunt	Best viewed after rainfall or in spring and early summer. Access road is narrow in places and is unpaved. Little Falls has a drop of 17m and Paradise Falls has a drop of 31m.
Paddys River Falls	Paddy's River Road, Tumbarumba	Lookouts are located just a short walk from the carpark or follow the walkway to the bottom.

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
