<b>Public Art Trail</b>	Scan the QR code and tour the trail at your leisure across Albury Wodonga.	 From sculptures to murals, wrapped infrastructure, art under foot & nestled in stunning vistas, the Albury Wodonga Public Art Trail will delight, surprise & captivate.
<b>The Crossing Place Trail</b>	Lemke Road, Gateway Island 02 6022 9300	A 5.1km loop along the Murray River. Discover the story of Yarre the Mailman, a scar tree, & spot wildlife including platypus, wedge-tailed eagles & the rare black-billed spoonbills.
<b>Yindyamarra Sculpture Walk</b>	Access via Kremur Street, Albury 1300 252 879	Wind your way along the Murray River for 5kms between Kremur Street & Wonga Wetlands. Fourteen sculptures crafted by Aboriginal artists tell age-old First Nations stories through contemporary art.

## History

<b>Albury CBD Historic Buildings Walking Tour</b>	Download the app or grab a map from Albury Visitor Information Centre 1300 252 879	The tour showcases 21 sites spread over 13 locations along Albury's Smollett & Dean Streets. Bollards mark the stopping points, with a brief description of each landmark.
<b>Albury LibraryMuseum</b>	Corner Swift & Kiewa Streets, Albury 02 6023 8333 Mon/Wed/Thu: 10.00am-7.00pm Tues/Fri: 10.00am-5.00pm Sat: 10.00am-3.00pm Sun: 10.00am-2.00pm	View The Crossing Place, Sharing Bonegilla Stories & Wiradjuri Talkback, permanent exhibitions which provide insight into Albury's past. Catch the latest exhibitions in the Lane Gallery & Temporary Gallery spaces, and check out the Community Wall in the library to see what's on display.
<b>Albury War Memorial</b>	Memorial Drive, Albury	Opened on Anzac Day 1925, the striking design is topped with a 'torch of liberty' & faced with 40 panes of prismatic glass.
<b>Army Museum Bandiana</b>	Murray Valley Highway, Wodonga 02 6055 2525 Thu-Sat: 10.00am-3.00pm	The largest & most diverse Military Museum in Australia. There are guns, tanks, vehicles, motorcycles, uniforms, medals and much more.
<b>Bonegilla Migrant Experience</b>	Bonegilla Road, Bonegilla 02 6020 6912 Open daily: 10.00am-4.00pm	Step back in time & discover the Bonegilla Migrant Reception & Training Centre. Explore the original camp buildings & walk in the shoes of the 320,000 migrants who made this site their first Australian home.
<b>Hume and Hovell Track</b>	Various locations. The Hovell Tree is located at Hovell Tree Park, Wodonga Place, Albury <a href="http://humeandhovelltrack.com.au">humeandhovelltrack.com.au</a>	Trace the footsteps of famous explorers across Eastern Hill & Big Budginigi Hill. Marking their journey's end by the Murray River is the Hovell Tree, where Hovell carved his name in 1824.
<b>Hume Dam Wall</b>	Murray Street, Lake Hume Village	A stroll across the top of the Hume Dam wall is the perfect way to appreciate its sheer scale. Completed in 1961, this impressive structure is now a National Engineering Landmark.
<b>Jindera Pioneer Museum</b>	Urana Street, Jindera 02 6026 3622 Open daily: 10.00am-3.00pm	Just 15 minutes from Albury is the charming village of Jindera, home to a Pioneer Museum set in & around the grounds of a general store & residence built in 1874.



## Nature

<b>Albury Botanic Gardens</b>	Corner Dean Street & Wodonga Place, Albury 02 6023 8111 Open daily: 6.30am-7.00pm	Opened more than 145 years ago, explore the 1000 plus native & exotic plants, enjoy a picnic on the lawn, visit the dinosaurs & fairy castle in the Children's Garden.
<b>High Country Rail Trail</b>	Trail starts corner Havelock and Osburn Streets, Wodonga 02 6023 6714	Stretching over 80 kilometres from Wodonga to Shelley & featuring the 600 metre Sandy Creek Bridge, one of Australia's most spectacular rail trails hugs the shoreline of Lake Hume.
<b>Huon Hill Parklands</b>	Whytes Road, Bandiana 02 6023 6714	At 428 metres above sea level, Huon Hill offers over 24 kilometres of trails, with several tracks along the Kiewa River. At the summit, enjoy 360-degree views of the Kiewa Valley, Lake Hume, & spot snow on Kosciusko and Bogong High Plains in the winter months.
<b>Lake Hume</b>	Riverina Highway, Lake Hume	At six times the size of Sydney Harbour, there's plenty of space to fish, swim, paddle, or relax. Pack a picnic & head to Kookaburra Point Reserve, or cross on the heritage listed Wymah Ferry.
<b>Lookouts</b>	Big Budginigi Hill Mitchell Road, Table Top Eastern Hill East Street, East Albury Huon Hill Whytes Road, Bandiana Kurrajong Gap Kurrajong Gap Road, Bethanga	Take in breathtaking vistas in Albury Wodonga, with magnificent views of rolling hills & grand waterways. Breathe the fresh air & discover native flora & fauna while you travel along the walking tracks, conquering the peaks of our spectacular lookouts.
<b>Murray River Canoe Hire</b>	Noreuil Park, Wodonga Place, Albury 0417 691 339	Canoe, kayak or river tube your way down Australia's iconic Murray River. Seasonal operation, call for bookings.
<b>Murray River Precinct/Noreuil Park</b>	Wodonga Place, Albury	Find places for swimming, kayaking, paddle boarding, bike riding, & relaxing on the riverbank. Stroll along the boardwalk or find the perfect picnic spot under mature shade trees. River Deck Café has coffee & takeaway food, & a fully enclosed playground lets kids play & parents relax.
<b>Nail Can Hill</b>	Various access points in West Albury. Grab a map from Albury Visitor Information Centre.	Nail Can Hill parklands feature wildflowers in spring, great views & flora secrets such as the critically endangered Spider Orchid. Single track trails cover nearly 30 kilometres, perfect for cyclists & hikers.
<b>Wagirra Trail</b>	Access via the Riverside Parks, Albury	Jump on the Wagirra Trail and enjoy a walk along the banks of the Murray. Explore a 15km return loop linking Wonga Wetlands to the South Albury Trail through blissful riverside parks among soaring red gums.
<b>Wonga Wetlands</b>	Riverina Highway, Albury Open daily: 7.30am-7.30pm	An ecosystem of lagoons & billabongs. Discover a haven for wildlife, birdwatchers, photographers, bushwalkers & families.
