Lake Hume Driving Loop

1. Eastern Hill	East Street, East Albury	Follow the trail behind the radio towers and walk along the ridgeline for views out to Lake Hume and the Alpine region. This section of Eastern Hill is part of the famous Hume and Hovell Walking track.
2. Hume Dam Wall	Riverina Highway, Lake Hume	Marvel at the engineering feat that is the Hume Dam Wall, Albury Wodonga's iconic landmark. Enjoy everything Lake Hume has to offer from swimming to fishing, boarding and boating or enjoy a walk or picnic in one of the reserves on the banks of Lake Hume.
3. Bonegilla Migrant Experience	Bonegilla Road, Bonegilla Open 7 days 10.00am-4.00pm	Visit the Post War Immigration Centre which housed over 300,000 migrants. Learn the stories of the migrants or explore your own family connections.
4. Huon Hill Lookout	Bakers Lane, Bandiana	Rising 263 metres above the Murray and Kiewa floodplains, Huon Hill lookout offers panoramic views across Lake Hume, the Alpine Region and Albury Wodonga. Ideal for bushwalking, sightseeing, picnicking and photography.
5. Hyphen Library Gallery	Hovell Street, Wodonga Weekdays: 10.00am-6.00pm Weekends: 10.00am-3.00pm	Where art and literature come together. Visit the Artspace, Playspace and Community Gallery. Impressive architecturally designed cantilever building offering library services.
6. Junction Place	Elgin Boulevard, Wodonga	Wodonga's town square precinct located in the old Railway yards. Great dining options at BeanStation Café, Miss Amalie, and The Goods Shed, or convenient takeaway at the Piccolo Pod shipping container. Grassy areas, eating pods and a small water splash park and playground for the kids.
7. Gateway Village	Lincoln Causeway, Wodonga	Albury Wodonga's arts precinct. Painting, pottery and woodturning galleries. Farmers Markets every Saturday morning from 8am.
