


Day Trips



Albury Wodonga is blessed with so many amazing places right on our doorstep, so why not stay a little longer and set up home base right here. Once you've seen all that our twin cities have to offer, jump in the car and venture further afield. We've put together four day-trips to help you explore North East Victoria and into New South Wales.





North

Total distance approx 158km

Dive into history in the Greater Hume. This day trip North of Albury Wodonga takes you through charming country towns brimming with history, natural wonders, and quirky encounters. Uncover the region's rich past at a pioneer museum, connect with nature at a unique environmental centre, snap some panoramas and spot bushranger hideouts at the lookout. Marvel at pottery masterpieces or take a deep dive in a submarine. Top a great day off with Australiana yesteryear, cold drinks, and a hearty counter meal at the iconic Ettamogah Pub.

Set the scene in the Upper Murray. This day trip east of Albury Wodonga will see you exploring charming towns, breathtaking vistas, and large-scale sculptures along the Great River Road. Pitstop at historic pubs with open fires or shady beer gardens, depending on the season. Whispers of the past and cattleman's tales are told in museums along the way. Stretch your legs on a nature trail or chase waterfalls in the National Parks. Don't miss the colossal Pine Mountain, one of the Southern Hemisphere's largest monoliths (bigger than Uluru!)

Explore the charming high streets for beautifully preserved architecture, vibrant art galleries, and unique retail shopping. Savour the region's distinct flavours from awardwinning wineries and breweries to fresh local farm produce. Amongst the rolling hills nature-lovers will lose themselves in the beauty of cascading waterfalls and scenic gorges. Keep your eyes peeled for unique flora and fauna along the way.



Immerse yourself in the region's Indigenous heritage through captivating art and don't miss the iconic Big Wine Bottle, a quirky landmark offering a good photo opportunity.
