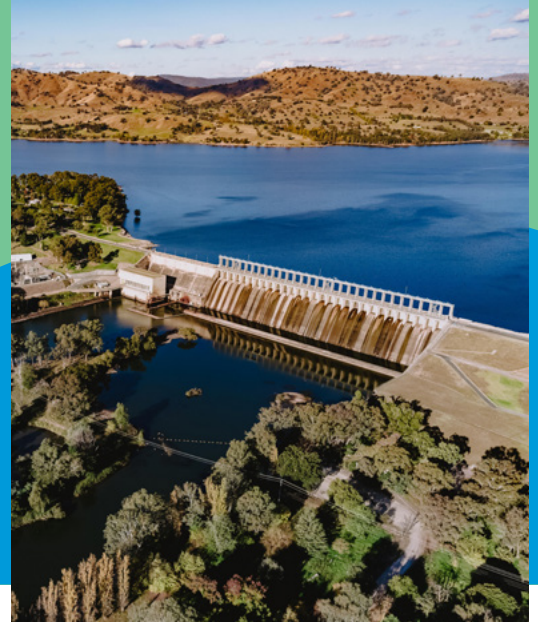


Lake Hume Driving Loop



Jump in the car for an easy day trip with generous views, impressive engineering at the Hume Dam Wall, touching migrant history, beautiful scenery, and a chance to relax. With seven stops in just under 60 kilometres and 90 minutes of driving time, the Lake Hume Loop is a wonderful way to explore the region.





Itinerary

1. EASTERN HILL

Follow the trail behind the radio towers and walk along the ridgeline for views out to Lake Hume and the Alpine region. This section of Eastern Hill is part of the famous Hume and Hovell Walking track.

2. HUME DAM WALL

A stroll across the top of the Hume Dam wall is the perfect way to appreciate its sheer scale. Completed in 1961, this impressive structure is now a National Engineering Landmark.

3. BONEGILLA MIGRANT EXPERIENCE

Step back in time & discover the Bonegilla Migrant Reception & Training Centre. Explore the original camp buildings & walk in the shoes of the 320,000 migrants who made this site their first Australian home.

4. HUON HILL

Rising 263 metres above the Murray and Kiewa floodplains, Huon Hill lookout offers panoramic views across Lake Hume, the Alpine Region and Albury Wodonga. Ideal for bushwalking, sightseeing, picnicking and photography.

5. HYPHEN - WODONGA LIBRARY GALLERY

Where art and literature come together. The impressive, architecturally designed building contains a gallery within the cantilever that extends over the entrance and gives Hyphen its name. Visit the Artspace, Playspace, and Community Gallery in this modern and unique library.

6. JUNCTION PLACE

Wodonga's town square precinct located in the old Railway yards. Stop for lunch at BeanStation Café, or The Goods Shed. Grab coffee at the Piccolo Pod or ice cream from Topolino.

There's grassy areas, eating pods, and a small water splash park and playground for the kids.

7. GATEWAY VILLAGE

A hub for artist studios, galleries, performance spaces, and the Burraja Indigenous Cultural Centre. Discover artworks along the 4.3km Gateway Island Trail, or simply meander through the village and enjoy the peaceful surrounds.
