## Murray River

### CANOE THE MURRAY

### KREMUR STREET BOAT RAMP

River access via a concrete slab ramp. The area has lighting, waste bins, and a fish-cleaning table. The Yindyamarra Sculpture Walk can be accessed from the car park.

### MUNGABAREENA RESERVE

A popular swimming and picnic area. The location's importance to traditional owners has been officially enshrined as a Declared Aboriginal Place.

Only accessible from Albury, but situated on the Victorian side of the Murray River. There is a small loop track around the reserve and several points of access to the river.

### APEX PARK (THE PINES)

Views of both the Mitta and Bowna arms of Lake Hume, and Bethanga Bridge. The boat ramp can be used by fishers, ski boats, and jetskis.

### EBDEN RESERVE

Located on the banks of Lake Hume beside the High Country Rail Trail.

### LAKE HUME HOLIDAY PARK

Day passes are available for \$10pp (or \$5pp if visiting a guest). Facilities include boat ramp, games room, golf course, swimmin pool, inflatable trampoline, and petting zoo.

### KOOKABURRA POINT

This small peninsula has two boat ramp locations, a lookout point, and plenty of shady trees, making it a great place to swim, or explore on foot.

Located on the banks of Lake Hume with a boat ramp and easy access for swimming, and access to the High Country Rail Trail. 1 night stays in a caravan or camper are permitted.

The ferry can take 3 cars and has a capacity of 30 tonnes. The Wymah Ferry crossing to Granya is one of only 2 surviving ferries that cross the Murray River between NSW and Victoria. Toll free.

# Waterfalls

## BARRY FALLS

Most spectacular during the spring months when there is still plenty of water runoff from the hills. The falls are an easy walk which is great for the whole family.

## BLUFF FALLS

Water cascades 30 metres off the plateau, over Cudgewa Bluff and into the grotto below. Parking and turning is limited.

## FAINTER FALLS

Water flows all year round, start the walk opposite the car park, follow the signed walking track for spectacular views of the falls and the river. The walk is approx. 700m.

## GRANYA FALLS

700m walk from Cottontree Creek picnic area. Nearby is Granya Scout Hut built in 1937.

## INDIGO FALLS

Secluded waterfall, just off Ewarts Road, approx. 50 metres from car park. Lush, green forest of Baranduda Ranges. The road is unsealed in sections and potholes are common.

## LADIES BATH FALLS AND ROLLASONS FALLS

Ladies Bath Falls – accessed via a short drive up the Mount Buffalo tourist drive, and a short walk to the falls. Further up the tourist drive is Rollasons Falls – a 3km return track to view waterfall from above and below. Parking is limited.

## PADDYS RIVER FALLS

Lookouts are located just a short walk from the carpark, and a walkway leads to the bottom for a closer look at the falls.

## PARADISE FALLS AND LITTLE FALLS

Best viewed after rainfall or in spring and early summer. Access road is narrow in places and is unpaved. Little Falls has a drop of 17m and Paradise Falls has a drop of 31m.

## WOOLSHED FALLS

This popular swimming spot is a ten-minute drive from Beechworth on the Beechworth-Chiltern Road. Viewing platform is located close to the carpark and there is access to explore the area around Falls.
