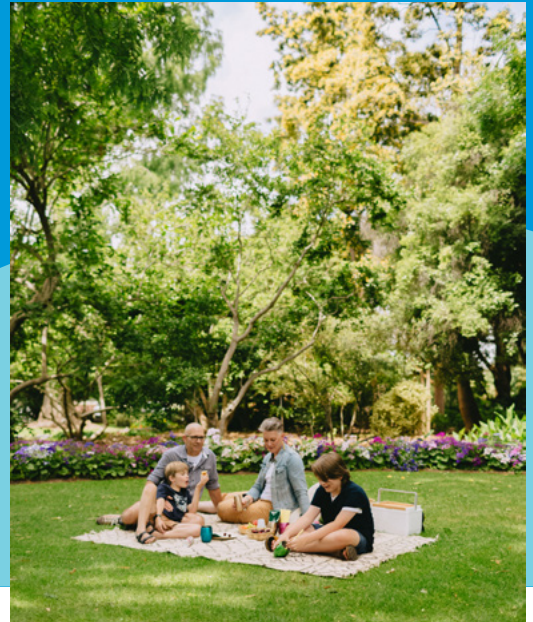


# Picnic Locations

## Lake Hume

### APEX PARK (THE PINES)

Views of both the Mitta and Bowna arms of Lake Hume, and Bethanga Bridge. The boat ramp can be used by fishers, ski boats, and jetskis.

📍 Recreation Lane, Albury (off Riverina Highway)



### EBDEN RESERVE

Located on the banks of Lake Hume beside the High Country Rail Trail.

📍 Murray Valley Highway, Ebden



### HUME DAM WALL

Stroll across the top of the Hume Dam wall and visit the lookout for photos of the dam and wall.

📍 Murray Street, Lake Hume Village



### JACKSON'S POINT RESERVE

Spectator vantage point for yacht racing. (Toilets locked 7.30pm – 6.30am)

📍 Lake Hume, Off Bonegilla Road



### KOOKABURRA POINT

This small peninsula has two boat ramp locations, a lookout point, and plenty of shady trees, making it a great place to swim, or explore on foot.

📍 76 Bonegilla Road, Bonegilla



### LUDLOWS RESERVE

Located on the banks of Lake Hume with a boat ramp and easy access for swimming, and access to the High Country Rail Trail.

## Parks and Gardens

### ALBURY BOTANIC GARDENS

Opened in 1877, the gardens contain over 1000 native & exotic plants. The Children's Garden is home to dinosaurs and a fairy castle.

### BELVOIR PARK

A multi-age playground with inclusive liberty swing, lakeside walk, exercise stations, and off-leash dog park.

## Murray River

### MUNGABAREENA RESERVE & WATER WORKS

Significant cultural reserve on the banks of the Murray River with a picnic area and boat ramp. Nearby Water Works is popular for swimming, kayaking and picnics.

### MURRAY RIVER PRECINCT & NOREUIL PARK

River access, bike paths, playgrounds, an exercise station, off-leash dog park, and space to relax on the riverbank.

## Surrounding Areas

### LAKE SAMBEL

A short stroll from the centre of Beechworth, a popular venue for water and boating activities, equipped with BBQs and picnic tables.

### TALLANGATTA FORESHORE (PELICAN PARK)

Access to Lake Hume, splash park, and sandpit. Don't forget to take a photo with the large silver Pelican.

### MEMORIAL PARK

Plenty of room to enjoy the Murray River. Fishing, open lawns, and an Enchanted Hut.

### THE WILLOWS RESERVE

The area is dotted with willow trees on a gentle and winding walk along the mighty Murray. The reserve aims to protect and conserve native flora and fauna.

📍 Short Street, Wahgunyah



### ROWERS PARK

The park has a quiet launching facility just for canoes and kayaks, and a lush lawn area. The Rivalea fishing platform is a great spot to try your hand at catching the elusive Murray Cod or Golden Perch.
